General Questions

1. What is Vacation Bible School (VBS)?

Vacation Bible School (VBS) is a fun, free, multi-day event designed especially for kids! Each day is filled with engaging Bible lessons, exciting games, creative crafts, tasty snacks, music, and lots of laughter. Think of it as a themed day camp where children can grow in faith, build friendships, and make lasting memories.

2. What is Rainforest Falls about?

This year's adventure is **Rainforest Falls**! Kids will step through the mist into a vibrant rainforest setting as they discover more about who God is and how deeply He loves them. Over the four days, they'll learn about His character, hear the good news of the Gospel, and discover what it means to be rooted and growing in a relationship with Him. We can't wait to explore this journey together!

3. What if we can only attend some of the days?

No problem! We're happy to have your child join us for any days your family is available.

4. How will we receive our free t-shirt/s?

If you register your child by May 10, their shirt will be ready for pickup on the first day of VBS. Any shirts not picked up that day will be available at the start of each following day until they are collected.

5. If we have more than one child, do they each get a free t-shirt?

Yes! As long as all your children are registered before our May 10 deadline, they will each receive a free shirt!

What Should We Bring?

We suggest bringing:

- Closed-toe shoes to protect feet during games and activities.
 - For elementary-aged children and up: A Bible for memory verse time. (If you don't have one, we're happy to provide one free of charge!)
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Safety & Security

1. What procedures are in place to ensure my child's safety?

Children are precious to us at Fairhaven, and we take our responsibility to care for and protect them seriously. Our goal is for every parent to feel confident and at peace while their child is with us. Some of the ways we prioritize safety include:

- Caring, trained, and carefully vetted volunteers and staff who serve together in teams.
 - A secure sign-in and sign-out system ensuring that only authorized individuals may drop off and pick up children.
 - Dedicated staff monitoring the grounds to ensure only registered participants are on site.
 - Registration forms where we collect important information such as: allergies, medical needs, and emergency contacts.
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Accommodations

1. What if my child needs special accommodations?

If your child has specific needs or would benefit from accommodations, please reach out to us at vbs@fairhavenbiblechapel.org—we are happy to work with you to meet your child’s needs in any way we can.

2. What if my Pre-K child is not yet potty trained?

Potty training is not required for this age group. However, if a diaper change is needed during the event, we ask that you choose one of the following options:

1. Provide permission for our staff to change your child’s diaper, if needed. (You may indicate your permission by checking the appropriate box on the sign-in sheet each day.)

OR

2. Remain on-site during the event so you are available to change your child if necessary.

We understand that this type of care can be a sensitive matter for parents. Our trained and thoroughly vetted staff follow clear, established policies for diaper changes and bathroom breaks to ensure your child’s safety and comfort.
