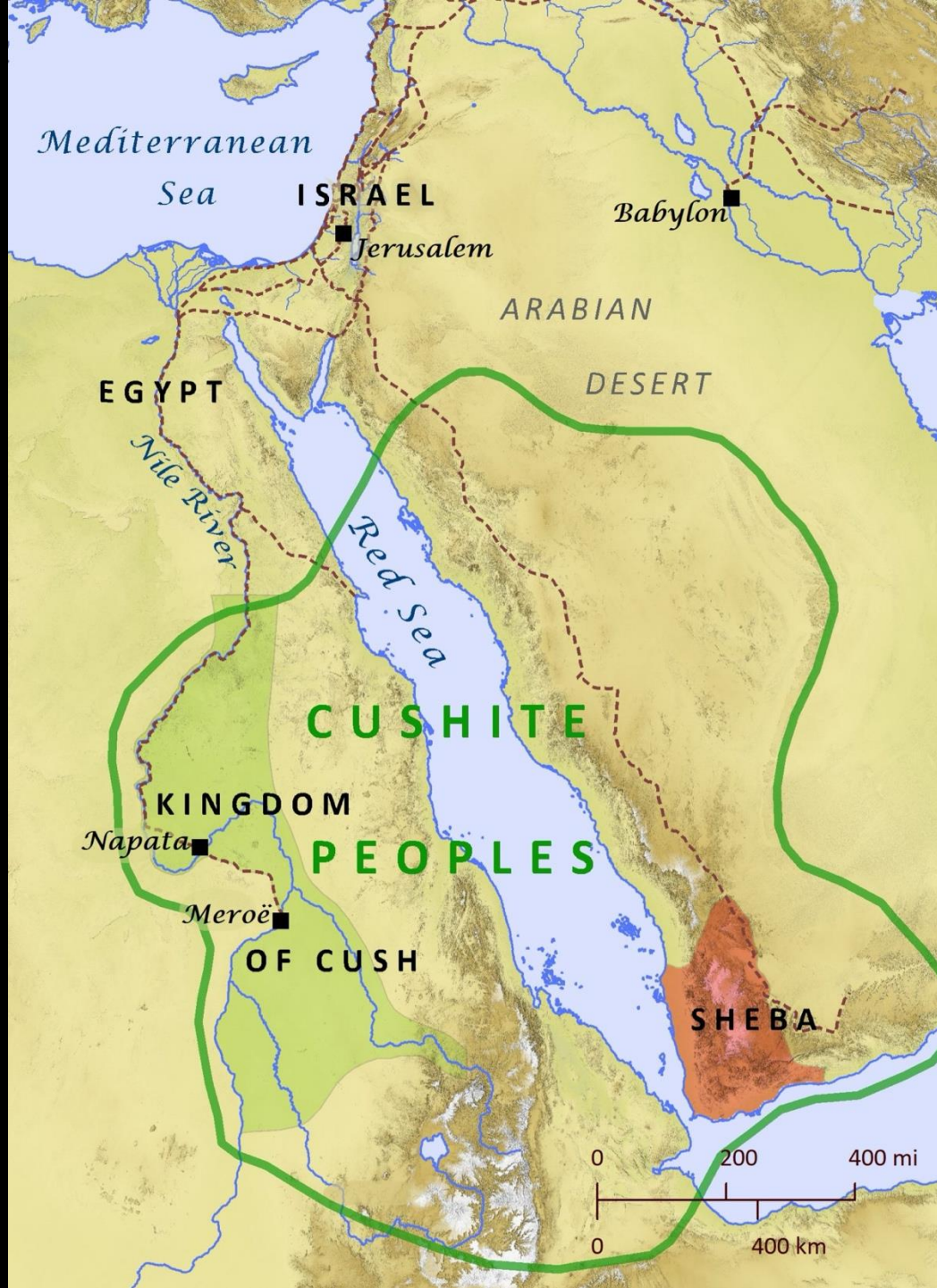

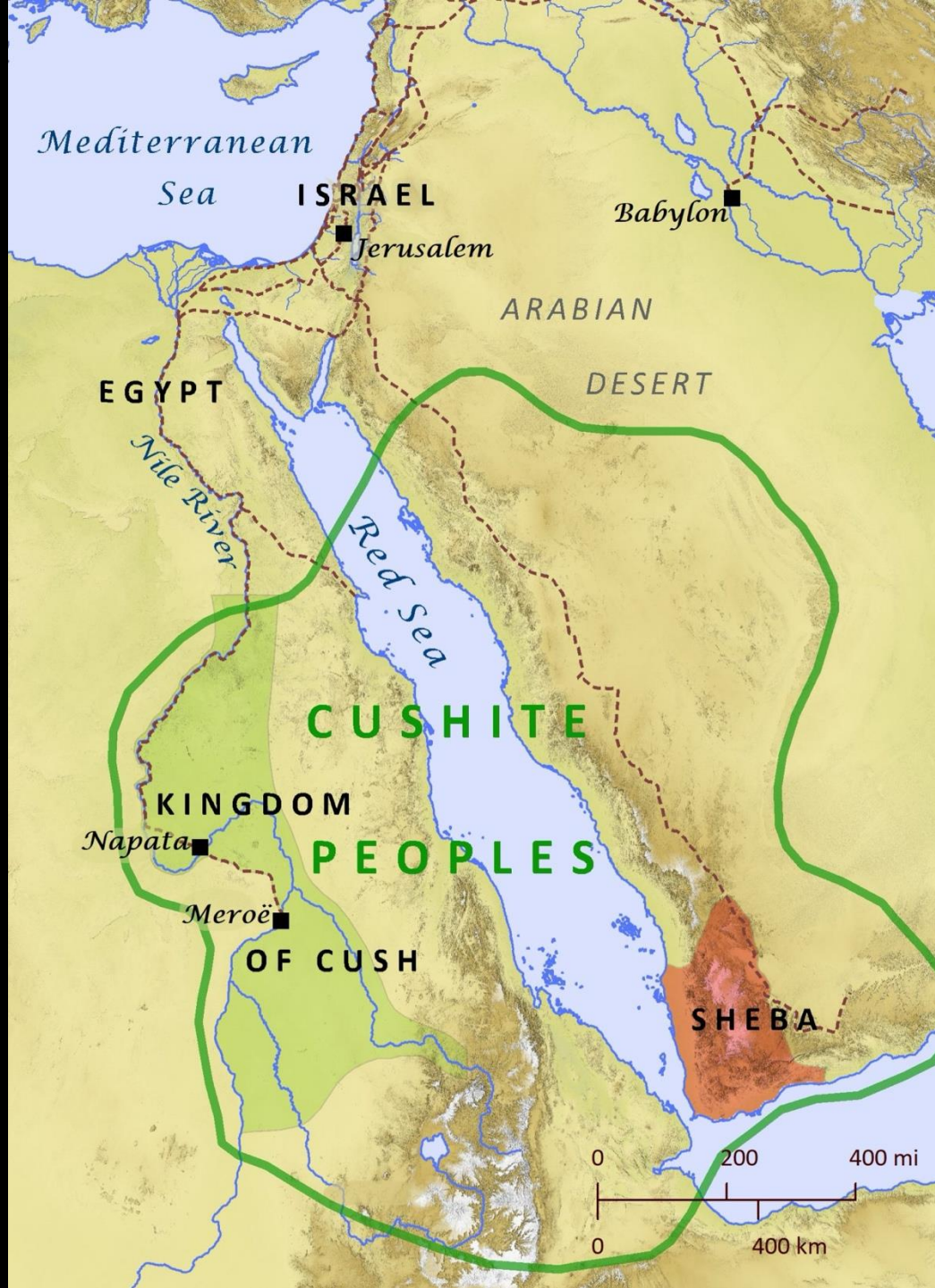
² at that time the LORD spoke through
