Isaiah 23:1 - Ships

The burden against Tyre.

Wail, you ships of Tarshish! / For it is laid waste,
/ So that there is no house, no harbor; / From
the land of Cyprus it is revealed to them.

Isaiah 23:2-3 - Sidon

Be still, you inhabitants of the coastland, / You
merchants of Sidon, / Whom those who cross
the sea have filled. / And on great waters the
grain of Shihor, / The harvest of the River, is her
revenue; / And she is a marketplace for the
nations.

Isaiah 23:4 - Sidon

Be ashamed, O Sidon; / For the sea has spoken, / The strength of the sea, saying, / “I do not labor, nor bring forth children; / Neither do I rear young men, / Nor bring up virgins.”

Isaiah 23:5 - Egypt

When the report reaches Egypt, / They also will
be in agony at the report of Tyre.

Isaiah 23:6-7 - Tarshish

Cross over to Tarshish; / Wail, you inhabitants
of the coastland! / Is this your joyous city, /
Whose antiquity is from ancient days, / Whose
feet carried her far off to dwell?

Isaiah 23:8-9 - Tyre

Who has taken this counsel against Tyre, the
crowning city, / Whose merchants are princes, /
Whose traders are the honorable of the earth? /
The LORD of hosts has purposed it, / To bring to
dishonor the pride of all glory, / To bring into
contempt all the honorable of the earth.

Isaiah 23:10-11 - Tarshish

Overflow through your land like the River, / O daughter of Tarshish; / There is no more strength. / He stretched out His hand over the sea, / He shook the kingdoms; / The LORD has given a commandment against Canaan / To destroy its strongholds.

Isaiah 23:12 - Sidon

And He said, “You will rejoice no more, / O you
oppressed virgin daughter of Sidon. / Arise,
cross over to Cyprus; / There also you will have
no rest.”

Isaiah 23:13 - Babylon

Behold, the land of the Chaldeans, / This
people that is not; / Assyria founded it for wild
beasts of the desert. / They set up their siege
towers, / They stripped its palaces, / And
brought it to ruin.

Wail, you ships of Tarshish! / For your strength

Isaiah 23:15-16 - Harlot's Song

Now it shall come to pass in that day that Tyre will be forgotten seventy years, according to the days of one king. At the end of seventy years it will happen to Tyre as in the song of the harlot: "Take a harp, go about the city, / You forgotten harlot; / Make sweet melody, sing many songs, / That you may be remembered."

Isaiah 23:17 - Harlot's Wages

And it shall be, at the end of seventy years, that the LORD will visit Tyre. She will return to her harlot's wages, and prostitute with all the kingdoms of the world on the face of the earth.

Isaiah 23:18 - Harlot's Wages

Her gain and her harlot's wages will be Holy to the LORD; it will not be treasured nor laid up, for her gain will be for those who dwell before the LORD, to eat sufficiently, and for fine clothing.

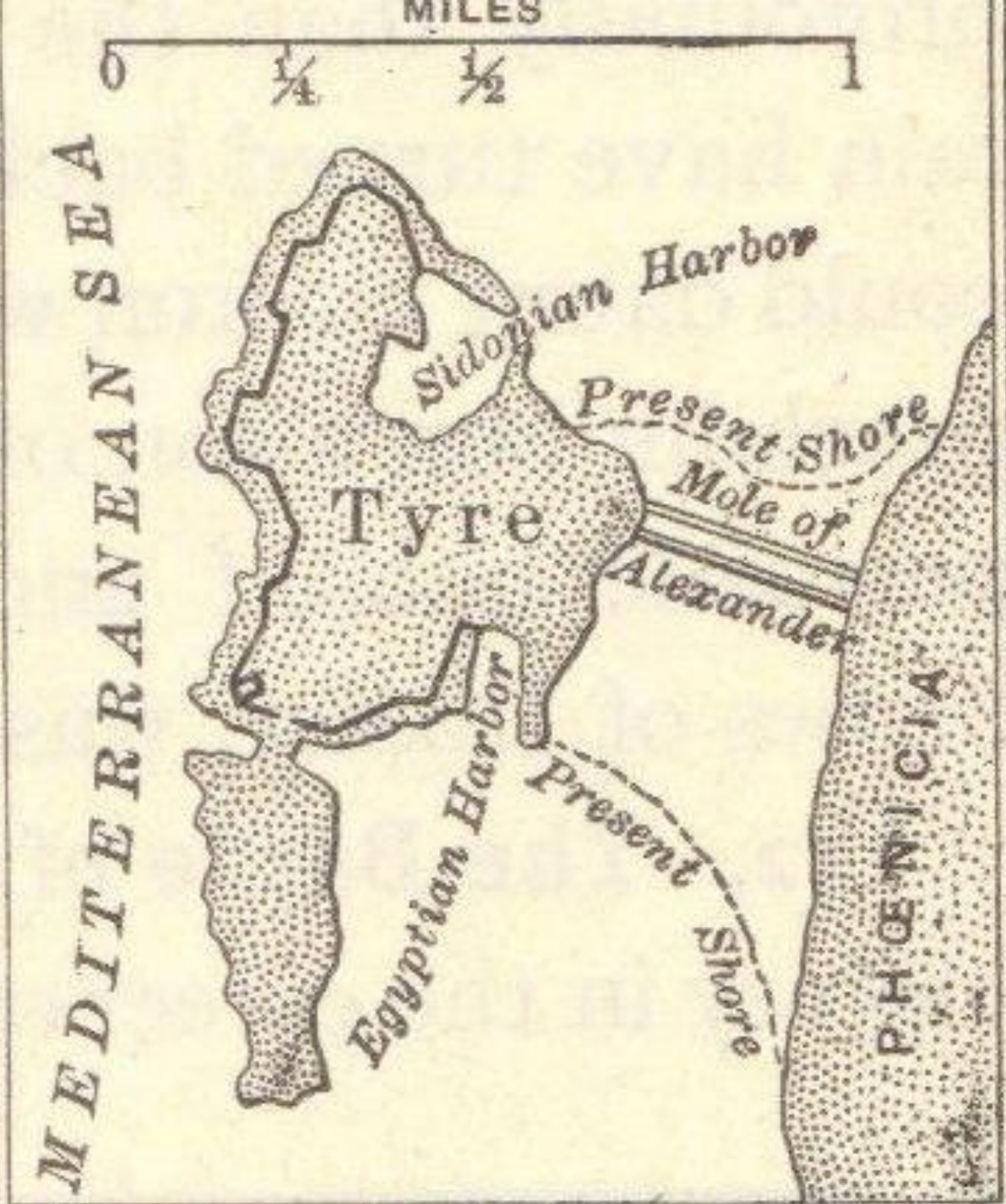
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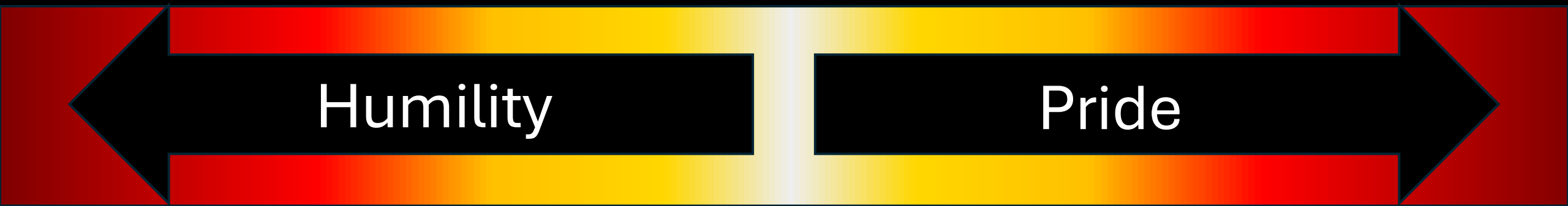
Isaiah 13:11 - Babylon

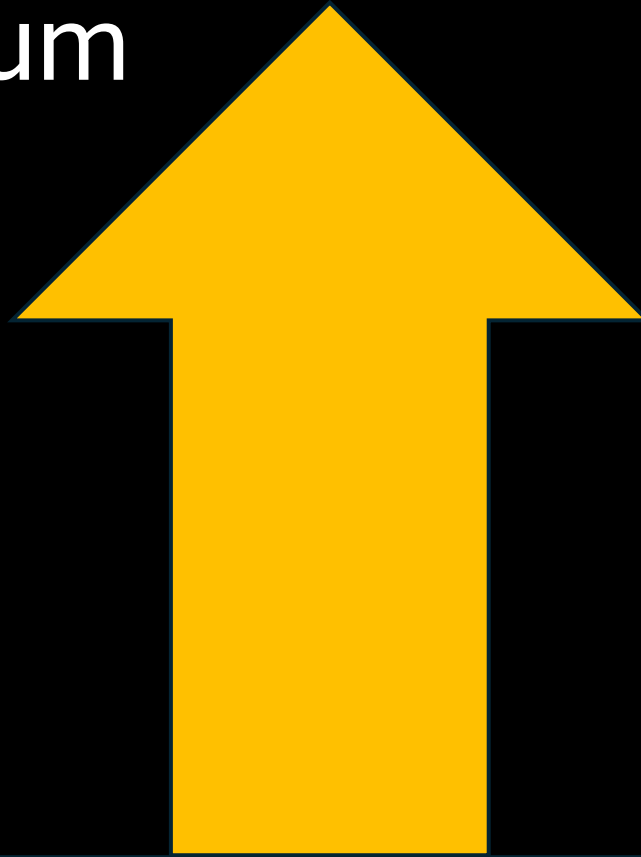
