## DISCUSSION QUESTIONS — Chapters 1 & 2

### Chapter 1: A Woman Adorned and Adorning (pp. 10-27)

1. What was one primary takeaway for you from this chapter?
2. Share about an older woman/spiritual mother God has used in your life.
3. What tools has God given to help us live out the beauty of the gospel (p. 19)?
4. Read 1 Thessalonians 5:11. What practical ways can you “pass the baton” (p. 21) in your daily life at home, church, or work?
5. How does the historical context of Titus 2 (p. 23), written during Nero’s reign, shape our understanding of what it means to live out the gospel in a challenging culture?
6. According to Titus 2:3-5, why is it vital for older women to intentionally invest in younger women? What generational blessings can result from this pattern?

## **Chapter 2: Doctrine, You, and Titus 2 (pp. 30-48)**

1. What was one primary takeaway for you from this chapter?
2. Read Ephesians 4:14 and 2 John 7-9. How have you seen “unhealthy” doctrine or a lack of sound doctrine affect your life or others you know?
3. Read John 8:31-32, Romans 6:17, and Jeremiah 31:33. How has sound doctrine impacted the way you live?
4. Read 1 Thessalonians 5:11. What practical ways can you “pass the baton” (p. 21) in your daily life at home, church, or work?
5. Do you think you’re more susceptible to believing wrong doctrine or to being “all head, no heart?” Explain your answer.
6. Reflect on Titus 2:13-14. How can the truth of God’s Word transform our character and relationships?
