Chapter 14: Instruments of Grace (pp. 308-328)

1. What was one primary takeaway for you from this chapter?
2. “The idea of Titus 2 womanhood intrigues us to see what God calls us to and what He could do through and in us” (p. 309). In light of this quote, what might be God’s “bucket list” for you? What might He be calling and equipping you to do? How might developing kindness equip you to fulfill this calling?
3. God isn’t just concerned about our actions but our motives behind our actions. Read. 1 Corinthians 13:1-4. What quality of love does v. 4 focus on here? Why?
4. How have you seen the absence or presence of kindness affect an act of service?
5. Why might the Lord allow an irritating and annoying person in your life? How might He use that person to build kindness into your life? How might you learn to show kindness to that person?
6. According to Romans 5:8, what kindness has Christ shown us? What were we like when He did that?)

7. At the top of p. 311, what does Nancy say our lack of kindness may show?
8. What are some hindrances to being kind listed on pp. 311-312? Which one is the toughest for you? Is there a promise God has given you to help you in that area?
9. What sacrifices could be involved in learning to show kindness to others?
